223-15 DOG BY-LAW Lanouette - Setlack

Whereas complaints were received from neighboring resident of 29 St-Gérard in the Town of Sainte-Anne because of excessive barking noise;

And whereas a registered letter was sent to Paula Kalyniuk to advise her of the violation of By-Law 5-2008 by harboring 5 dogs;

And whereas the Town of Sainte-Anne has jurisdiction under *The Municipal Act* to seize the animals and impose all cost of seizing to the owners;

Be it resolved that the Town deny the request for the harboring of 5 dogs. The Council of the Town of Sainte-Anne will allow the harboring of the existing 5 dogs for 30 days from today, being October 8th, 2015 to allow for the relocation of the extra animals.
