Public Information Meeting – Paving of Gagnier Bay

- Mayor Pelletier opened up the meeting at 7:00 pm with an explanation of options to having Gagnier Bay paved. The C.A.O. explained that the Town had received quotes from three different paving companies and with a total of \$184,349 plus fees and interest, the rate payers estimated cost not based on frontage as was previously proposed by the Town, but an equal amount divided between each property on Gagnier Bay. This would be a Local Improvement and each rate payer on Gagnier Bay would contribute their portion of payment. With 33 properties, including one property owned by the Town itself, an estimate was provided and could change.
- Questions brought up by the residents in attendance were about ditches and which companies were asked for quotes. Operation's Manager John Desrochers answered the questions by saying ditch problems are being looked into, with the possibility of filling the ditches with subsurface drainage. Asphalt was the preferred choice by the Town; however, a resident had asked about a seal coat option. Quotes were given by Borland Construction, Darco and Maple Leaf.
- The future maintenance will be by the Town Public Works. John also noted that the road will be paved as a crowned road with shoulders, similar to how Langevin Road is, and also will include a walking path for residents on the side.
