### Tips:

Recycle: Tin cans, aluminum cans, cardboard (decomposed/cut up), newspaper, paper, cereal boxes, milk jugs, glass, clear containers, yogurt containers

Non-Recyclable: Styrofoam, tissue paper, wrapping paper, paper towels, diapers, food, clothes, toys, aerosol cans, plastic furniture
