VOTING PLACES

Voting places will be open for voting on **Wednesday the 28th day of October 2026** between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. (day of the week) (day of the month) (month) (year)

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at **Town of Ste. Anne Office, 14 Centrale Ave, Ste. Anne** and will be open during each of the following days **Wednesday, October 21, 2026** between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on **October 26, 2026**:

- 1. Villa Youville, 15, chemin Charriere Rd, Ste. Anne**
- 2. Hospital Ste-Anne Hospital, 52 St. Gerard St, Ste, Anne**

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, or by email to the senior election official at **14 Centrale Ave, Ste. Anne or SEO@steanne.ca.**
